Psalms 6:3a My soul is in deep anguish.

John 12:27 "Now my soul is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? No, it was for this very reason I came to this hour.

Psalms 8:2 Through the praise of children and infants you have established a stronghold against your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger.

Matthew 21:16 "Do you hear what these children are saying?" they asked him. "Yes," replied Jesus, "have you never read, "'From the lips of children and infants you, Lord, have called forth your praise'?"

Psalms 22:1 My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from saving me, so far from my cries of anguish?

Matthew 27:46, Mark 15:34 About three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "*Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?*" (which means "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?").

Psalms 22:7 All who see me mock me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads.

- Matthew 27:39 Those who passed by hurled insults at him, shaking their heads
- Mark 15:29 Those who passed by hurled insults at him, shaking their heads and saying, "So! You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days,

Psalms 22:8 "He trusts in the LORD," they say, "let the LORD rescue him. Let him deliver him, since he delights in him."

Matthew 27:43 He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now if he wants him, for he said, 'I am the Son of God.'"

Psalms 22:18 They divide my clothes among them and cast lots for my garment.

- John 19:24; compare Matthew 27:35; Mark 15:24; Luke 23:34
- "Let's not tear it," they said to one another. "Let's decide by lot who will get it." This happened that the scripture might be fulfilled that said, "They divided my clothes among them and cast lots for my garment." So this is what the soldiers did.

Psalms 31:5a Into your hands I commit my spirit; deliver me, LORD, my faithful God.

Luke 23:46 Jesus called out with a loud voice, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit." When he had said this, he breathed his last.

Psalms 34:20 he protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken.

John 19:36 These things happened so that the scripture would be fulfilled: "Not one of his bones will be broken,"

Psalms 38:11 My friends and companions avoid me because of my wounds; my neighbors stay far away.

Luke 23:49 But all those who knew him, including the women who had followed him from Galilee, stood at a distance, watching these things.

Psalms 69:21 They put gall in my food and gave me vinegar for my thirst.

Matthew 27:34,48 There they offered Jesus wine to drink, mixed with gall; but after tasting it, he refused to drink it. 48 Immediately one of them ran and got a sponge. He filled it with wine vinegar, put it on a staff, and offered it to Jesus to drink.
